- ❖ 73.5% of persons without disabilities aged 18 to 64 are employed.³
- ❖ 33.9% of PwDs aged 18 to 64 are employed.³
- 4,800 persons aged 16 to 20 have a disability.¹
- 40,200 persons aged 21 to 64 have a disability.¹
- 68,830 people who live in DC have a disability.³
- The employment gap between PwDs and people without disabilities in DC decreased by 3.3% between 2010 and 2011.³
- 16,031 PwDs aged 18 to 64 received SSDI or SSI benefits in 2012.3
- The total expenditure on SSDI benefits in DC in 2012 was \$184,380,000.3
- Voc. Rehab. received 2,201 applicants in DC in 2012.3
- Voc. Rehab. obtained 501 jobs for PwDs in DC in 2012 (out of 2,201 applicants).²




Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 16 to 20 in District of Columbia in 2012




Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 21 to 64 in District of Columbia in 2012


