Gov. Larry Hogan (R)

- 78.3% of persons without disabilities aged 18 to 64 are employed.³
- 40.0% of PwDs aged 18 to 64 are employed.³
- 622,682 people in MD have a disability.³
- 321,409 persons aged 18 to 64 have a disability.³
- ❖ The Employment Gap between PwDs and people with disabilities has decreased 0.3% pts between 2010 and 2011.³
- 56,600 PwDs aged 18 to 64 receive benefits.¹
- ❖ In 2012, MD's total expenditure on SSDI benefits was \$1,922,172,000.3
- Voc. Rehab. received 9,405 general applicants in MD 2012.3
- Voc. Rehab. obtained 2,506 jobs for PwDs in MD in 2012.²



Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 16 to 20 in Maryland in 2012


Prevalence Rates: Age 16 to 20 years (%)

Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 21 to 64 in Maryland in 2012


Prevalence Rates: Age 21 to 64 years (%)


